

## SAILOR LEVEL

<b>NOVICE</b>	Opti Tots Ages 6-8	No sailing experiences. First time sailors who are comfortable around the water and wearing a personal flotation device (PFD).
<b>SEAMAN</b>	Beginner	No (beginner skills for younger sailors moving up a fleet) sailing experience required. Focus on boating safety, terminology, wind awareness, basic sail trim, and steering a course.
<b>MATE</b>	Intermediate	Proficient at basic sailing. Introduction to rules of the road, basic navigation, boat and sail controls, expanded tiller time, upwind sailing, and intro to racing.
<b>SKIPPER</b>	Advanced	Capable skipper and crew. Focus on advanced boat handling, course sailing, starting a race, racing rules, tactics, and strategy in both skipper and crew roles.

<b>Opti Pram</b>		Ages 6-11 designed for young sailors and up to 80lbs. Novice and Seaman sail with partners
<b>Sunfish</b>		Sailors ages 9-12. Designed for sailors 60lbs+. Beginners sail with partner, intermediates and skippers sail solo wind dependent
<b>Feva XL</b>		Double-handed dinghy designed for ages 12+ over 80+lbs. Intermediate & Advanced sailors are introduced to Spinnaker Handling
<b>J22</b>		One design 22' keelboat. Used for Adult classes, Bay Cruiser weeks, Intermediate and Skipper Classes to intro spinnaker, race skills, and to further explore the Bay.
<b>Kayaks</b>		4 Adult & 4 Child sit-a-tops
<b>Paddleboards</b>		6 Cruiser and 4 Bic Paddleboards
