

2023 is the 25th anniversary of the Chesapeake Bay Initiative Act which authorized the National Park Service (NPS) and other agencies to collaborate for the betterment of the Bay. NPS manages the Chesapeake Gateways Network which includes a diverse collection of natural, cultural, historical, and recreational sites, trails, museums, parks, refuges, and interpretive and orientation facilities. The very popular John Smith Water Trail, enjoyed by sailors and paddlers alike, is a key component of the Chesapeake Gateways Network.
