Maryland's smallest owl, the Northern Sawwhet Owl, weighs less than a bar of soap, yet travels thousands of miles over its lifetime. Each fall, these tiny travelers pass through Maryland during their annual migration.

Since 2017, as a volunteer, Melissa has run an owl research and banding station at the Smithsonian Environmental Research Center in Edgewater.
