Sarah is one of two senators representing Maryland on the multi-state Chesapeake Bay Commission, Sarah works with colleagues in Pennsylvania and Virginia to build regional consensus and implement policy solutions to protect and restore the Bay.

She is also Senate Chair, Joint Committee on the Chesapeake and Atlantic Coastal Bays Critical Areas.

As our Senator, Sarah has successfully passed bills to increase oyster populations, invest in clean energy jobs and committing Maryland to reaching 50% renewable energy by 2030, build more resilient infrastructure in response to climate change, plant 5 million trees in the next 10 years; and strengthen the State's Commission on Environmental Justice. Sarah chairs the Subcommittee of the Budget overseeing all environmental programs and passed a critical update to MD's Forest Conservation Act.
